



Exclusion Periods

Medication / Ailment	Exclusion Period
Chicken Pox	5 days from diagnosis or until spots have dried, whichever is longer
Conjunctivitis	Until eye discharge stops or treatment begins
Covid-19	72 hours
Diarrhoea	48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea
Hand, Foot & Mouth	5 days from diagnosis or until spots have dried, whichever is longer
Headlice	Once treatment is complete and free of headlice and eggs
Medication	24 hours after the first dose of a <u>new</u> medication
Paracetamol/Ibuprofen (e.g., Calpol)	12 hours
Temperature $\geq 38^{\circ}$	24 hours
Vaccinations	24 hours
Vomiting	48 hours after the last episode of vomiting
Other	Please enquire for guidance

HOW IT WORKS

We base our exclusion periods on governmental guidelines which can be found on the www.gov.uk website. We may apply more stringent exclusion periods, regardless of the guidelines, if we feel the risk to the other children, staff or families is significant.

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
